**Admission Guidelines**

**1. Admission Requirements**

Bachelor's Degree in Electrical and Electronics or Electronics and Communication Engineering with minimum 50% in aggregate or minimum CGPA of 2.0 (on a 4 point grading system)

**2. Recommended Prerequisites**

University undergraduate level knowledge in Mathematics, Analog Communication, Digital Communication, Digital Signal Processing, Signal and System, Electronics Devices, Electromagnetics, Computer programming skill, Numerical computation skill, English written and verbal communication skills.

**3. Student Intake, Scholarship and Duration of Program**

Maximum Number of Students Intake: 10

Scholarship Covers Full Tuition Fee

Students may be provided limited financial support for attending seminars and conferences to present their papers based on availability of funds.

## **6. Application Guidelines**

1. All the information must be typed in block letters. Fill up the form and print after completion. All mandatory fields must be filled.
2. Fill your names correctly as mentioned in your academic credentials.
3. Affix your recent MRP passport size photograph (35mm×45mm) in the box allocated.
4. Permanent Address means the address mentioned in the citizenship certificate or passport.
5. Correspondence Address means the address where the applicant may be contacted. Please mention the correct address that can be easily accessible.
6. Industrial sponsored students must clearly mention the category of applicant.
7. Applicants applying under the ‘*sponsored*’ category must include an official letter from the sponsor along with other documents.
8. All students, except those applying for ‘*sponsored*’ category, will be automatically considered for competition in fee waiver scheme.
9. Applicants with best merits (*based on the score of entrance exam, interview and final grade of bachelor level*) will be receiving the scholarship grant. The grant will be offered to

the students with next higher merits in case the first selected candidates do not complete the admission process within the stipulated date.

10. In case of female candidates, the female candidate with highest merit other than those eligible for the scholarship will be offered admission under the reserved seat category for female.

11. Students with highest merit among the sponsored category will be offered admission.

12. The application will not be considered complete without the signature of the declaring candidate in the hard copy.

13. Application should include all the testimonials as mentioned in section 5 “*Document to be Submitted*” in order.

14. In case of any deviation of information furnished by the applicant, the application or admission of the candidate is liable to cancellation at any stage of evaluation.
